

CPCO Standing Committees

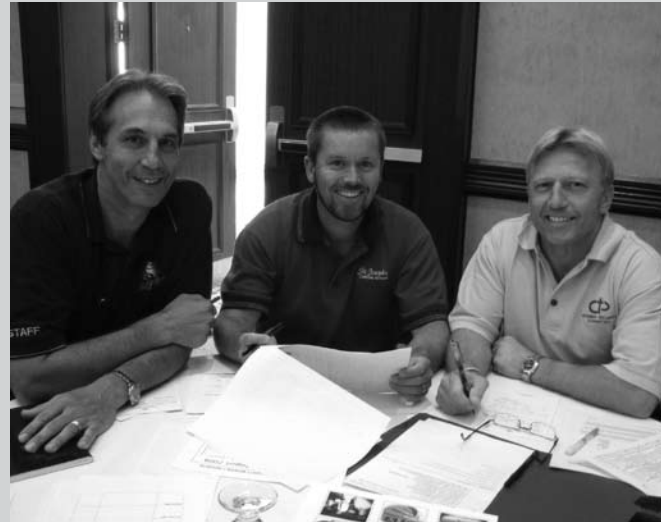
