



Call for Instructors

Fall 2010 – Summer 2012 CPCO Principal's Qualification Program Parts 1 and 2

As an Ontario College of Teachers accredited provider of the Principal's Qualification Program (PQP), CPCO is committed to developing and delivering a leadership formation program that reflects our Gospel values, is rooted in current research and practice.

CPCO is beginning its next cycle of recruitment and hiring of PQP instructors for 2010 – 2012. Successful instructors must have as a minimum:

- ▶ 5 years experience as a principal;
- ▶ qualities of a life-long learner as demonstrated by participation in workshops, conferences, courses, personal reading;
- ▶ experience as a leader of adult learning in a variety of situations;
- ▶ proficiency in the use of computer technology for communication and learning;
- ▶ and
- ▶ membership in good standing with the Ontario College of Teachers.

An application package must be submitted to Program Director Patty Orecchio no later than **June 7, 2010**. The package should include:

- ▶ Completed application form (electronic version is available on the CPCO website under PQP)
- ▶ Resume of experience
- ▶ Three reference letters from a peer, a supervisory officer, and a member of the local principal/vice-principal association executive.

Applicants will be interviewed in Toronto on **June 15, 16 or 17, 2010**.

Successful candidates will be required to participate in an instructor's formation session in Toronto in September 2010.
